EXEMPTION 2

Essential or emergency services workers who DO NOT have a current APY entry permit and are exempt under the *Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act 1981* Permits By-Law of 2009 you must:

- Anyone entering Australia from any international destination from the 25 October 2021, which is one month prior to the WHO announcement of the OMICRON Covid19 variant is not permitted entry onto the APY Lands
- Be fully vaccinated with two doses: strictly No Jab, No Entry
- Provide proof of COVID-19 vaccination status only from myGov
- Before entry onto the APY lands identify to APY permits the nature of the essential or emergency work you are carrying out by email to permits@anangu.com.au
- Must wear a mask for 7 days in all public spaces on the APY Lands after entry
- Must wait for approval from APY permits

APY is seeking a Direction from the Commissioner of Police, South Australia pursuant to the *Emergency Management Act 2004* South Australia with respect to these entry requirements.

¹ Section 4 of the *Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act 1981* SA defines “Añangu” as “a

person who is (a) a member of the Pitjantjatjara, Yankunytjatjara or Ngaanyatjarra people; and (b) a traditional owner of the lands, or a part of them.
