EXEMPTION 3

Essential or emergency service workers who do not have a current APY entry permit and who are not exempt from the requirement for a permit pursuant to the *Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act 1981 Permits By-Law of 2009* must adhere to the following entry requirements:

- Provide a statutory declaration from your employer that the following are the employers minimum COVID 19 work safety requirements:
- Employees are double vaccinated
- Provide personal proof from MYGOV of your double vaccination status
- Before entry onto the APY lands identify to APY permits the nature of the emergency work you are carrying out by email to permits@anangu.com.au
- Anyone entering Australia from any international destination from the 25 October 2021
- which is one month prior to the WHO announcement of the OMICRON Covid19 variant is not permitted entry onto the APY Lands

APY is seeking a Direction from the Commissioner of Police, South Australia pursuant to the *Emergency Management Act 2004* South Australia with respect to these entry requirements.

¹ Section 4 of the *Anangu Pitjantjatjara Yankunytjatjara Land Rights Act 1981* SA defines "Anangu" as "a

person who is (a) a member of the Pitjantjatjara, Yankunytjatjara or Ngaanyatjarra people; and (b) a traditional owner of the lands, or a part of them.
